- Electronics (TV, computer, etc.)
- Household hazardous materials (paint, pesticides, cleaning supplies, motor oil, etc.)

## What NOT to bring

For proper disposal of these items, contact the Chelsea Transfer Station at 734-475-7955.

- Bulky household items (mattress, furniture, etc.)
- Construction and demolition waste (drywall, concrete, wood, bricks, etc.)
- Household garbage

Bring 1 TV, computer or appliance for free. We request a donation of \$10 for each additional item.
