Please take notice that any qualified elector of the City of Chelsea who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the City Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained on the City website at www.city-chelsea.org. Click on 'Clerk' then 'Election Information' or at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, October 19, 2020**. After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector of the City of Chelsea may register to vote in person with **proof of residency** (MCL 168.492) at:

State

Proposal 2020-1

A proposed constitutional amendment to allow money from oil and gas mining on state-owned lands to continue to be collected in state funds for land protection and creation and maintenance of parks, nature areas, and public recreation facilities; and to describe how money in those state funds can be spent.

Proposal 2020-2

A proposed constitutional amendment to require a search warrant in order to access a person's electronic data or electronic communications.

County

Washtenaw County Proposal

Proposition to authorize the renewal and restoration of a 0.25-Mill for the purpose of purchasing natural areas in order to preserve them, paying the costs of operating a land preservation program and paying the costs of maintaining the land purchased

Local School District

Chelsea School District Operating Millage Renewal

This proposal will allow the school to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2020 tax levy.
